Below are some important notices – please be sure to read them thoroughly.

Attendance

At Cheddar Grove Primary, we strive promote excellent school attendance every single day.

Our school gates/doors open at 8:50 am and learning starts at 9:00 am sharp - children need to be in class on time to benefit fully from the school day. All children from Nursery through to Year 6 need to be in school by 9am.

Children who are late and arrive at school after 9:00 am will be recorded as late in the register. Please can we encourage all parents/carers to bring children to school on time.

If you are going to be late due to extenuating circumstances, please contact the school office. All absence due to illness must be reported at the earliest opportunity to the school's absence line.

For any pre-arranged absences due to medical appointments, we will request medical evidence as proof of appointments – please drop into the school office or send an email to office@cheddargroveschool.org.uk.

For any pre-arranged absences for holidays/any other circumstances, an Absence Request Form will need to be completed – please contact the school office for a form should you require one.

Safety Notice

We politely ask that there should be no riding of scooters/bikes/skateboards in the school playground at any time, including during drop-off and collection times. To keep everybody safe, we encourage you to carefully wheel these items through the playground if your child rides to and from school.

Collections During the School Day

We appreciate that at times you may need to drop-off or collect your child during school hours, for example for medical appointments etc. We ask that you refrain from dropping off/collecting during lunchtime – latest drop-off/collection before lunch should be 12:00pm and earliest time after lunch for drop-off/collection is 1:15pm. If it is unavoidable that your child needs to be dropped-off/collected during lunch time, please speak to a member of the School Office Team.

The children have all been working so hard in Term 3, with lots of house points being awarded. The winning house this term was Lupus! Huge congratulations Lupus!


Girl's Football Match

Year 1 made a moving picture using a side to side or up and down slider.


Year 2 made a moving animal using levers and pivots.

Water Bottles

Please remember that children need to come to school every day with a clearly labelled water bottle. This can be refilled in class throughout the day as required. There are still some children coming to school without a water bottle. Thank you for your cooperation.



Parking

Please can we reminder all parents/carers of thoughtful and conscientious parking. Can parents please refrain from parking on single yellows and in front of driveways. We pride ourselves on being a community school and as such, we support our community in any way we can.

School Uniform

Please can we politely remind all parents/carers that school uniform MUST consist of:

- School logo polo shirt or plain bottle green/white
- Plain **black** skirt, shorts or school trousers (no leggings)
- School logo jumper/cardigan or bottle green jumper/cardigan
- Black school shoes/trainers











<u>PE kits</u> still form part of our uniform policy and as such, there should be no deviation from the items listed below.

PE kits MUST consist of:

- Plain white top/T-shirt/polo shirt
- Plain **black** shorts/legging/jogging or tracksuit bottoms
- School jumper, cardigan, or **plain black** hooded fleece/jumper
- Black trainers

Children need to come to school wearing their PE kit, <u>on their relevant PE days</u>. Full school uniform must be worn to school on non-PE days.

Please do not send children to school wearing 'branded' clothing such as hoodies with logos, denim jackets, or football kits as this does not constitute school uniform.











<u>Jewellery</u>

Children can only wear stud earrings and a watch to school. Please no hoop earrings or bracelets.

If any children are not wearing the correct school uniform or PE uniform, parents/carers will be contacted.

MCAS Payment system/Communication





We highly recommend setting up the MCAS app if you have a smart phone, due to this now being the main way we will send out communication. We will also be using the system to book breakfast club and trips etc. If you are experiencing any problems, please contact the office.

Announcements



Tap the loudhailer icon on the toolbar. Any announcements posted by the school will display the title and date. To view the announcement, simply tap it and scroll in the message window as necessary. To return to the main **Announcements** page, tap the **< Announcements** arrow. To viewany attachments, simply tap on them.



Messages

The Messages feature allows the user to send, receive and reply to messages through the *Parent*App. Simply tap Messages from the toolbar. To compose a message, tap the pencil, use the dropdown menu to select the recipient of the message (school or teacher if enabled), add a title, compose and *Send*. To abandon a message, simply tap the X in the Messages heading. To display either *Received* or *Sent* messages, simply tap the respective tab and tap again to view the message. A *Reply* option is available for the message.

If you haven't already, please can we ask for you to update your child's photo permissions on your MCAS app. Please can we ask that this is updated ASAP as this



will affect children being able to be photographed during performances.
